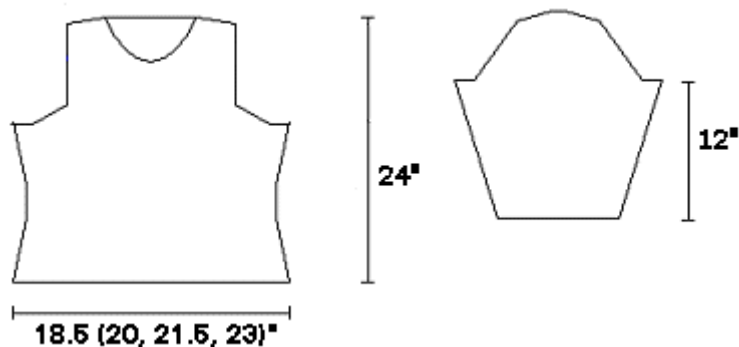


Teal Hogget (02/21/06)

Disclaimer: This pattern is being presented without previous test-knitting and therefore may contain errors. Any errors found will be corrected.



Actual Chest Measurement: 37 (40, 43, 46)", Actual Length: 24" long

900 (950, 950, 1000) yards worsted weight yarn

Needles: 1 pair straight and one 16" circular 4.5mm (US size 7) needles, or size to get gauge

Gauge: 4 stitches and 6 rows per 1"

Abbreviations

k	knit
k2tog	knit 2 stitches together
p	purl
p2tog	purl 2 stitches together
ssk	Slip, Slip, Knit - slip one stitch as if to knit, slip another stitch as if to knit, stick point of left needle in two slipped stitches in front of the right needle and knit.
tbl	through back loops

Back

Cast on 74, (80, 86, 92) stitches and work in seed stitch as follows:

Row 1: (k1, p1) across.

Row 2: (p1, k1) across.

Work a total of 6 rows in seed stitch.

Continue in stockinette stitch (k1 row, p 1 row) and work 13 rows further, a total of 19 rows from the beginning.

Next row (wrong side): P1, p2tog, p to last 3 stitches, p2tog tbl, p1.

Work 19 rows.

Next row (wrong side): P1, p2tog, p to last 3 stitches, p2tog tbl, p1.

Work 19 rows.

Next row (wrong side): P1, make 1, p to last stitch, make 1, p1.

Work 19 rows.

Next row (wrong side): P1, make 1, p to last stitch, make 1, p1. 74, (80, 86, 92) stitches.

Work until piece measures 14" from the start. (84 rows).

Armhole Shaping:

Bind off 5 (6, 7, 8) stitches at beginning of next 2 rows.

Decrease 1 stitch each side on the next row and each alternate row a total of 7 times thusly: k1, ssk, k to last 3 stitches, k2tog, k1. 50 (54, 58, 62) stitches remain.

Work even until piece measures 23" from start. (138 rows)

Shape Shoulders:

Bind off 3 (4, 4, 4) stitches at the beginning of the next 4 rows, then bind off 4 (4, 5, 6) stitches at the beginning of the next 2 rows.
Bind off 30 (30, 32, 34) back neck stitches.

Front

Work as for back, including all shaping, and, at the same time when piece measures 20" (row 120), begin neck shaping:

Work 21 (23, 24, 25) stitches, attach another ball of yarn, bind off center 8, (8, 10, 12) stitches, work remaining 21 (23, 24, 25) stitches to complete row. Work both sides at once.
Bind off 2 stitches at each neck edge 2 times.

Decrease 1 stitch at each neck edge, every other row 7 times.

Work even until piece measures 23" from start (138 rows).

Shape Shoulders

Work shoulder shaping (at shoulder edge) to correspond with back.

Sleeves

Cast on 38 (40, 42, 44) stitches and work in seed stitch as follows:

Row 1: (k1, p1) across.

Row 2: (p1, k1) across.

Work a total of 6 rows in seed stitch, then continue in stockinette stitch.

*Shape sleeve by increasing 1 stitch on each side every 4th row 15 times until you have a total of 68 (70, 72, 74) stitches.

Work even until sleeve measures 12" from the beginning (72 rows).*

*Long sleeve option: Work between the *-* as follows:*

Shape sleeve by increasing 1 stitch on each side every 5th row 15 times until you have a total of 68 (70, 72, 74) stitches.

Work even until sleeve measures 17 (17, 17½, 18)" from the beginning (102, 102, 105, 108 rows).

Cap Shaping:

Bind off 5 (6, 7, 8) stitches each side.

Decrease 1 stitch each side on the next row and each alternate row a total of 9 times, then decrease 1 stitch each side on every row 8 times.

Bind off 3 stitches at the beginning of next 4 rows.

Bind off the remaining 12 stitches.

Finishing

Weave in all ends and block pieces.

Join front and back at shoulders. With short circular needle, pick up and knit 84 (86, 88, 90) stitches around neck edge. P 1 round, k 1 round, then bind off purlwise.

Set sleeve caps in armholes, then join side and sleeve seams.

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
