

# Summer Mystery Shawlette - Part Two

Before starting Part Two, you will have completed all 12 rows of Chart A as described in Part One.

## Work Chart B:

**Row 1:** K3, \*work the first 11 st of chart, work across the 12-stitch pattern repeat 7 times, work across the remaining 10 st of chart,\* k1 (center stitch), repeat between \* \*, k3.

Note that you will decrease 1 stitch at the beginning and end of the chart so that at the end of Row 1 you will have on the needle 10 stitches before the first repeat and 9 stitches after the last repeat.

**Row 2 (and all even-numbered rows):** K3, purl to the last 3 stitches, k3.

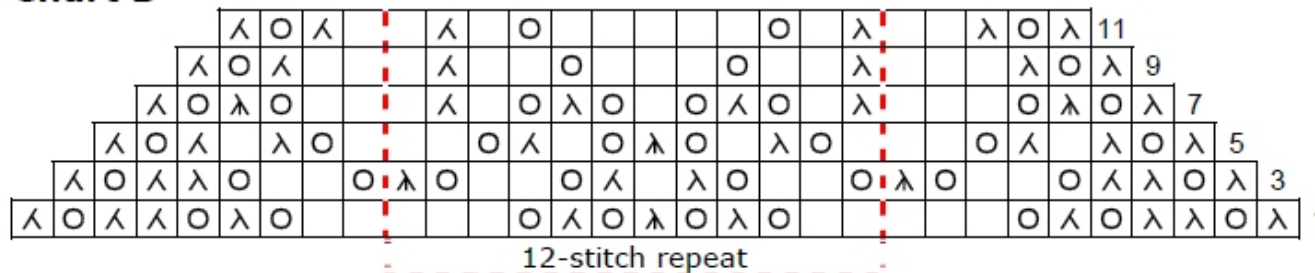
Note that on Row 3 of the chart the pattern repeat begins after a double-decrease. There are yarnovers before and after this double-decrease to compensate for the 2 stitches decreased. On this row you will work to 2 stitches before the beginning of the marked repeat, and will work the double-decrease on the 2 stitches before and 1 stitch after the beginning of the repeat. If you are using a stitch marker, you need to slip the first 2 stitches of the decrease from the left to right needle, remove the marker, slip the first stitch after the marker from the left to right needle, replace the marker, then slip the 3 stitches you moved from the left to right needle back to the left needle. Now work the double-decrease on the 3 stitches that are now before the marker on the left needle.

Also note – on Row 7 the decreases at the beginning and end of the chart are different from the other rows. Instead of starting with “ssk, yo, ssk” and ending with “k2tog, yo, k2tog,” Row 7 starts “ssk, yo, sl1 k2tog pssso, yo” and ends yo, sl1 k2tog pssso, yo, k2tog.”

Work all 12 rows of Chart B, working the even-numbered chart rows as Row 2.

At the end of Chart B you will have 193 stitches on the needles (93 stitches in each chart section plus 3 edge stitches at each end plus 1 center stitch).

## Chart B in Words

**Row 1:** k3, \*ssk, yo, ssk, ssk, yo, k2tog, yo, k3, (k2, yo, ssk, yo, sl1 k2tog pssso, yo, k2tog, yo, k3) 7 times, k2, yo, ssk, yo, k2tog, k2tog, yo, k2tog\* k1, work between asterisks again, k3 (213 stitches)

**Row 2 and all even-numbered rows:** k3, p to last 3 sts, k3

**Row 3:** k3, \*ssk, yo, ssk, k2tog, yo, k2, yo, sl1 k2tog pssso, (yo, k2, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k2, yo, sl 1 k2tog pssso) 7 times, yo, k2, yo, ssk, k2tog, yo, k2tog\* k1, work between asterisks again, k3 (209 stitches)

**Row 5:** k3, \*ssk, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k2, (k1, yo, ssk, k1, yo, sl1 k2tog pssso, yo, k1, k2tog, yo, k2) 7 times, k1, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k2tog\* k1, work between asterisks again, k3 (205 stitches)

**Row 7:** k3, \*ssk, yo, sl 1 k2tog pssso, yo, k3 (ssk, k1, yo, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, yo, k1, k2tog, k1) 7 times, k2, yo, sl1 k2tog pssso, yo, k2tog\* k1, work between asterisks again, k3 (201 stitches)

**Row 9:** k3, \*ssk, yo, ssk, k3, (ssk, k2, yo, k3, yo, k2, k2tog, k1) 7 times, k2, k2tog, yo, k2tog\* k1, work between asterisks again, k3 (197 stitches)

**Row 11:** k3, \*ssk, yo, ssk, k2, (ssk, k1, yo, k5, yo, k1, k2tog, k1) 7 times, k1, k2tog, yo, k2tog\* k1, work between asterisks again, k3 (193 stitches)
