

Shetland Pi Shawl KAL – Part Four

You have completed Part Three and have 288 stitches on your needle.

Increase Round 6: (Knit 1, yo) around, so that you have doubled the number of your stitches – 576 stitches.

Work 2 rounds, knitting all stitches. While knitting the second round, place a stitch marker after every 9th stitch, if desired, to help you keep your place in the pattern.

Work **Chart D**, repeating the 9 stitches of the chart 64 times over the 576 stitches on your needles. Work Chart D 6 times for a total of 48 rounds of lace worked.

Note: On Round 5 of the pattern you are decreasing 2 stitches in each pattern repeat. On Round 6 you will increase 2 stitches in each pattern repeat.

Chart D Pattern in Words

Round 1: [K3, yo, sl1 k2 tog, pssso, yo, k3] repeat 64 times.

Round 2, 4, and 8: knit all stitches.

Round 3: [K2, ssk, yo, k1, yo, k 2 tog, k2] repeat 64 times.

Round 5: [K1, ssk, yo, sl1 k2 tog, pssso, yo, k2 tog, k1] repeat 64 times.

Round 6: [k2, k in front & back of the yo from the previous row to make 2 sts, k1, k in front & back of the yo from the previous row to make 2 sts, k2] repeat 64 times.

Round 7: [Ssk, yo, ssk, yo, k1, yo, k2 tog, yo, k2 tog] repeat 64 times.

After you finish working 48 rounds of Chart D, work 1 round, knitting all stitches.
