

Shetland Pi Shawl KAL – Part Three

You have completed Part Two and have 144 stitches on your needle.

Increase Round 5: (Knit 1, yo) around, so that you have doubled the number of your stitches – 288 stitches.

Work 1 round, knitting all stitches. While you knit this round, place a stitch marker after every 6th stitch, if desired, to help you keep your place in the pattern.

Work **Chart C**, repeating the 6 stitches of the chart 48 times over the 288 stitches on your needles. Work Chart C a total of 12 times, for a total of 48 rounds of lace worked.

Chart C Pattern in Words

Round 1: [yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k1] repeat these 6 stitches 48 times.

Round 2 and 4: knit all stitches.

Round 3: [k1, yo, sl1 k2tog, pss0, yo, k2] repeat these 6 stitches 48 times.

After you finish working 48 rounds of Chart C, work 2 rounds, knitting all stitches. While you knit the second round, remove all your stitch markers except the one that marks the beginning of the round.
